SPECIAL CALLED
CITY COUNCIL MEETING

September 21, 2022

The Mayor and the council members present were Concetta Amey, Paul Parker, and Vallarie Cuttie.

Mayor Cuttie called the special meeting of the city council on Wednesday, September 21, 2022, at 6:00 pm and the meeting was held in the city's cafetorium for the discussion of agenda items: **1.)** Request for a Business License and **2.)** Agreement with Community Supervision Services, LLC.

- 1.) The meeting opened with Mr. Charlie Smith of "Charlie Smith Trucking, LLC explaining his plans for the portable office building to be located at 161 South Main. And he answered questions of the Mayor and Council.

Next, Mayor Cuttie called for a motion, and Concetta Amey made a motion, seconded by Vallarie Cuttie, and passed unanimously to grant a business license to Mr. Smith.

- 2.) Mayor Cuttie explained that he had received the agreement yesterday and that the company has been providing community service for violators of the law for the city for the past 20 years. In addition, the service does not cost the city as the company keeps 33% of the probation fees paid by the probationary.

Then, Mayor Cuttie called for a motion for him to sign the agreement to enter into service. And Paul Parker made a motion, seconded by Vallarie Cuttie, and passed unanimously.

Finally, now that all business had been discussed, Mayor Cuttie called for a motion to end the special called meeting. And Concetta Amey made a motion seconded by Vallarie Cuttie, and passed unanimously.
